With 26,654 affordable housing units - 40% of all affordable housing in all Travis County- Precinct 4 contains the most affordable housing out of all other Precincts. However, only 2,254 of the 26,654 (8%) subsidized units in Precinct 4 are located outside of the City of Austin.


